General Conditions for Eligible Tenderers		

SI No	Conditions
1	Tenders from Joint ventures are not acceptable.
2	Bidders shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt and fraudulent practices issued by any State Government / Government of India /Union Territory.
3	It shall be the responsibility of the Bidder to ensure credit of Tender Processing Fee and EMD into the respective receiving bank accounts of e-Procurement on or before the last date and time of bid submission.
4	The bidder is required to ensure browser compatibility of the computer well in advance to the last date and time for receipt of tenders. The departments shall not be responsible for non-accessibility of e-Procurement portal due to internet connectivity issues and technical glitches at bidder's end.
5	EMD Payments through e-Payment mode shall be made as one single transaction and payments made in part are liable for rejection.
6	Bidder shall pay Contract Management Module processing fees of 0.025% of the contact value (Min Rs.500/- & Max Rs.7500/-) soon after contract has been issued to bidder.
7	Bidders shall ensure upload of relevant document certifying his/her status as Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/other reserved category as prescribed in the tender document.
8	Conditional Tenders are liable to be rejected . The officer competent to accept the tender shall have the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever.

9	The contractor has to make his own arrangements for procurement of all the required materials and the materials so procured shall confirm to the relevant IS Specifications and obtain necessary quality certificate from authorized quality control.
10	The Contractor is fully responsible for the Equipment / Material until the same is handed over to the EXECUTIVE ENGINEER in an operating condition after commissioning. The Contractor is responsible for the proper maintenance of equipment / material as well as protection of the same against theft, elements of nature, damages etc., while in his custody as well as after erection until the same is taken over by the EXECUTIVE ENGINEER under due acknowledgment in writing
11	Name, address, telephone, email id and fax numbers of the contractor is to be provided
12	During the execution of work, if any minor minerals are required contractors have to abide by the Karnataka Minor Mineral Concession Rules 1994 (as amended up to date). As per the prevailing rules, for any use of Minor Minerals, the contractor has to submit the Mineral Dispatch Permit (MDP) obtained from Mines and Geology Department. If Mineral Dispatch Permit (MDP) is not submitted by the contractor along with the bill, the prevailing penalty and DMF contribution as per Karnataka Minor Mineral concession rules 1994 (as amended from time to time) will be deducted from contractors bills at the time of payment.

13	The contractor shall quote the rates without adding GST either materials or works contract (service). GST payable by the Contractor under this works Contract will be paid to the Contractor separately over and above the Contractors bid amount. The increase if any in the GST shall not be paid in the extended period of contract for which the contractor alone is responsible for delay as determined by the authority.
14	The tenderer shall also disclose if there are any bankruptcy proceedings against him.

17	Sub-Leasing/G.P.A of Work is Prohibited.
18	Each Item of BOQ to be read as with all lead and lifts as per the direction of Engineer in charge.
19	Uploaded drawings are for TENDER PURPOSE ONLY
20	The statements showing the value of existing commitments and on-going works as well as the stipulated period of completion remaining for each of the work listed should be countersigned by the Employer in charge, not below the rank of an Executive Engineer or equivalent.

21	Income Tax : Latest copy of the Income Tax Clearance Certificate and Sale Tax Clearance PAN and TAN Nos. to be uploaded.

23	Scanned signature of the bidder/ firm/ company authorized representative of the bidder/ firm/ company shall be attached while uploading bid document.
24	If any of the dates mentioned above happens to be a general holiday, the next working day holds good.
25	The tender processing charges paid by the bidder/ firm/ company are not refundable even if the tenders are cancelled.
26	Typographical errors if any will not be the ground for any claims by the contractor.
27	The contractor should furnish the name of the staff / firm with address and telephone No. with place of registration, year of incorporation, etc.
28	The intending bidder firm/ company are advised to visit the work site before submission of tenders.
29	The necessary certificates/ documents in support of eligibility criteria fulfilled as stipulated shall be scanned and attached to e-tender documents. The original certificate/ documents shall be produced for verification when demanded, otherwise the tender will be treated as non-responsive bid and rejected.

34	As per the Karnataka Building and other construction workers welfare Cess Act 1996, 1% of the bill amount will be deducted from the bills
35	While uploading the bid document in the E portal the blanks in the bid document should be filled up with appropriate details wherever necessary.
36	The contractor has to furnish Additional Performance Security Deposit for unbalance tender as per clause 29.1 of ITT, to an amount equal to the difference in contract price and amount put to tender, in addition to 3% performance guarantee (in any of the form prescribed) while concluding the Agreement.
