General Conditions for Eligible Tenderers		

SI No	Conditions
1	Tenders from Joint ventures are not acceptable.
2	Bidders shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt and fraudulent practices issued by any State Government / Government of India /Union Territory.
3	It shall be the responsibility of the Bidder to ensure credit of Tender Processing Fee and EMD into the respective receiving bank accounts of e-Procurement on or before the last date and time of bid submission.
4	The bidder is required to ensure browser compatibility of the computer well in advance to the last date and time for receipt of tenders. The departments shall not be responsible for non-accessibility of e-Procurement portal due to internet connectivity issues and technical glitches at bidder's end.
5	EMD Payments through e-Payment mode shall be made as one single transaction and payments made in part are liable for rejection.
6	Bidder shall pay Contract Management Module processing fees of 0.025% of the contact value (Min Rs.500/- & Max Rs.7500/-) soon after contract has been issued to bidder.
7	Bidders shall ensure upload of relevant document certifying his/her status as Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/other reserved category as prescribed in the tender document.
8	Conditional tenders will not be accepted.
9	The tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of his tender, and the employer will in no case be responsible and liable for those costs.

10	The cost of the Tender form shall not be refundable.
11	The employer is not responsible for any delay in accessing E - Procurement Portal.
12	Contractors Should be registered with KPWD as Class-II and above Contractor.
13	Royalty on construction materials and other taxes will be deducted as per prevailing Govt orders.
14	All the formats prescribed in the bid document shall be filled by the tenderer in complete manner otherwise it will be rejected.
15	All scanned documents to be uploaded shall be in original and the Executive Engineer reserves the right to verify the documents before approval.
16	The employer reserves the rights to Reject or accept any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons.
17	The intending contractors are requested to note that they should abide by the detailed instructions and conditions contained in the Standard Tender documents KW-4 K.P.W.D. and further orders thereon.
18	In the case of the death of the contractor after executing the agreement , commencement of the work, his legal heir, if is an eligible registered contractor and is willing can execute and complete the work at the accepted tender rates irrespective of the cost of the work
19	The tenderer should maintain the Road works during the defective liability period for 1 years.

20	Contractor should take all precautions to ensure that no damage is caused to any adjacent structures/utilities above or below the ground and also to the existing canal CD works and other similar structures which have been constructed by other agencies during project execution. If any damage is caused, it has to be rectified at his own risk and cost.
21	All safety precautions, warning signs, night illumination, reflectors, deployment of security guards has to be ensured so that no untoward incident happens on account of negligence or any project activity. Contractor should indemnify the client to that extent.
22	Formation levels and other data furnished are bare minimum; the contractor should make all efforts to validate and to get additional data if required at his own cost.
23	Contractor should execute the project with least impact to the environment till the completion of project.
24	Further particulars, if any, required by the Contractor can be had from the office of the Executive Engineer, PWD, Chikkaballapur Division, Chikkaballapur during office hours on all working days.
25	All materials required for the work like bitumen, steel, cement etc., shall be procured by the tenderer themselves and should got tested by the quality control authority before use on the work at their own cost.
26	The contractors assessed available tender capacity will be calculated as per the clause 3.6 of standard tender document Attached. For calculation of tender capacity A and B values must be furnished work wise duly signed by the authorized signatory.

27	All the items in the tender including all lead, lifts, loading unloading, transportation, labour, hire charges of machinery curing for concrete works, cost and convene of all matiral and all other such incidental charges necessary for successful completion of works as per the detailed technical specification and direction of Engineer-in-charge of this work.
28	When embankments are constructed disputes arising on account of damages to the existing field channels, bunds and other private properties, if any, has to be resolved by the contractor. All precautions should be taken by the contractor so that there are no damages to such public/ private properties.
29	Contractor should take all precautionary measures to avoid any damage to the utilities during excavation as well as utility shifting. To that extent the contractor should indemnify the client.
30	Contractor should follow strictly the prevailing rules of labour act & The contractor should employ only registered labours as per Govt. Circular No. PWD/198/BMS/2009/ Dated: 24-06-2009
31	The increase in GST shall not be paid in the extended period of contract for which the contractor alone is responsible for delay as determined by the authority while granting the extension of time.
32	GST Shall be paid to the contract amount separately

33	<p>Participating agencies should compulsorily possess GST and PAN numbers. GST number should be valid and in force at the time of participation. Agencies should upload these documents and 3 months GST returns filed prior to uploading of tender filed earlier. Otherwise, the bids of those agencies will not be considered for valuation</p>
34	<p>The contractor along with his financial bid shall furnish a detailed rate analysis for such of the items where he has quoted lesser rates than the estimated rates. The rate analysis must indicate break up of rates for various components such as materials, labour, machinery and other relevant components. He shall also explain &amp; substantiate how such lesser quoted rates would work out for him from the point of view of doing quality work. He shall also give undertaking that the rates quoted by me are workable to execute quality work as per specification and to the fullest satisfaction of the department Any failure on the part of the contractor in not fulfilling the above said information along with his Financial bid in e-proc is liable for rejection of his Financial Bid.</p>
35	<p>As per the Government Circular No.PWD:ITC:2008/2099, Dated.2-12-2010, the tendered contractors, should submit the Original Bank Guarantee issued by the Bankers for the said work at the time of opening of the Technical Bids. The Contractors failing to submit the Original Bank Guarantees will be disqualified and the initial amount deposited through E-payment will be forfeited and also such contractors will be Black listed and Debarred from participating in future tenders.</p>

36	Royalty on construction materials and other taxes will be deducted as per prevailing Govt. orders. As per Karnataka state Government order LD/300/LET/2006 Bangalore dated 01.01.2007 and Government letter no PW/134/BMS/2007 dated 27.07.2007, a sum amounting to 1% of the bill amount will be deducted towards constructions labour welfare fund.
37	The successful tenderer should provide monthly physical and financial progress to be achieved in Bar chart/Milestone chart/PERT chart during agreement.
38	The returns submitted to the I.T. along with the Profit and Loss account statement, Balance sheet should be uploaded for the financial turnover criteria attested by registered Chartered Accountant with UDIN No.
39	The successful Tenderer shall deliver to the Employer a Security deposit in any of the forms given Clause 29.1 of ITT for an amount equivalent to 3% (As per G.O. No.FD 456 Exp-12/2022, Bangalore Dt:10-08-2022, Security Deposit for an amount equivalent to 3% up to 31-12-2023) of the Contract price plus additional security for unbalanced tenders in accordance with Clause 25.5 & 29.1 of ITT and Clause 44 of the Conditions of Contract.
